URBAN IDEAS

With No Land - How to grow on walkways, decks, spare rooms etc...

1. Building growing systems for others - sell online
2. Building plans / blueprints selling – how and where to get materials.
3. Coaching, on farming, animal husbandry or any specialty
4. Courses, create and sell online about farming or building a growing system etc
5. Crayfish, raise and sell for food and bait
6. Garden other people's properties for them
7. Garden other properties (rent them) for yourself and sell at market
8. Herbs and natural, cures make medicinal
9. Herbs and oils, make your own culinary
10. Herbs, dried
11. Herbs, grow live ones in planters to sell
12. How to books or instructions
13. Sell your preserves or instruction on how to make them in print or video
14. Live bait, sell
15. Microgreens, sell
16. Mushrooms, sell
17. Natural organic cosmetics, create your own line of face mask (strawberry and stevia)
18. Natural organic cosmetics, create your own line of lip balm
19. Novelties, t-shirts, hats, garden signs, plant markers etc.
20. Organic recipes, sell yours
21. Plants, sell grown and producing
22. Plants, sell starter seedlings
23. Produce, aggregate farmer with your own products and other farms
